Assistant Director Report

Mrs. Alyx Bickel reported on:

- Kiwanis Club of Yorkville presented IVVC with \$5000 to provide to directly assist students with costs associated with IVVC programs. This is the second year the Kiwanis Club of Yorkville has granted \$5000 to IVVC. They plan to continue providing funds yearly that IVVC will help distribute to students seeking financial assistance.
- IVVC Scholarships that were presented at Senior Awards Night.
- The Gustafson Scholarship winner was a Plano student in the Auto Body Repair Program.
- IVVC has been approved to offer dual credit for Basic Nurse Assistant Training (NAS1-1 6 CR) and Maintenance & Light Repair (AUT101 2 CR) for the 2025-2026 school year.

Board Policy Committee

Mr. Joe Barbic explained that Wayland Middendorf is no longer on the board, so he is requesting a replacement. The Press update 118 has been released and the committee will need to review and make recommendations.

CTEI/Perkins Disbursements

- CTEI IVVC has an allocation of \$500,920 for 2024-2025. \$412,157.21 has been received to date.
- Perkins IVVC has an allocation of \$81,572 for 2024-2025. \$30,366 has been received to date.

Technical Honor Society recognition

Mr. Joe Barbic reported that an IVVC rep will be at 8 home school awards ceremonies to present Technical Honors. There are 118 students receiving the honor this year.

Construction Trades Update

The estimated cost for completion is \$359,675.44. Mr. Barbic expects the house to be ready for sale by our June Board of Control meeting.
